Head Coach's Code of Conduct

I acknowledge that my primary responsibility is to promote a healthy, pleasant and safe environment for youth to participate in youth sports. I fully understand that youth sports should be a fun, rewarding and positive learning experience for all participants, and playing time is key to providing that experience for my team members. To satisfactorily meet this responsibility I will:

Fully abide by the policies, rules and guidelines set forth by Tri-County Youth Football Alliance and successful completing all coaching/volunteer requirements; Respect the game officials and refrain from communicating with them in an abusive manner; Encourage Tri-County Youth Football Alliance fans to conduct themselves with sportsmanship and maturity at all times while in attendance at Tri-County functions. Assist the game officials in maintaining control of spectators during games; Be a positive role model for players by never: Using or tolerating obscene language and gestures; Physically or verbally intimidating; Abusing or assaulting a player; Making discriminatory remarks based on race, religion, gender or national origin; Consuming or allowing the consumption of alcohol or be an inebriated state during practices, games, or in the presence of my players; Encouraging, tolerating, or indulging in substance abuse; Smoking or using tobacco products in front of a player during practice, games, or other official team functions.
